Case examples

Commercial agency claim

Dispute over two aspects surrounding a service contract governing the provision of care services to individuals. At its core the dispute was contractual, and involves claims and counterclaims by both parties.

Dispute between a beneficiary and an executor of an estate, both of whom were left a percentage share of the deceased's business. The executor is seeking to sell the business to the other two parties who receive the remaining 48% of the business under the will but the value is disputed.

Share dispute.

Breach of warranty claim following the sale of a hotel.

Unfair prejudice claim.
